# Regulations for the mountain classification at the Gran Fondo Gdynia (hereinafter referred to as "Classification")

#### I. General information

1.1. The organizer of the Event is Sport Evolution Group Sp. z o.o., Jana Kochanowskiego 12/23, 01-864 Warszawa, registered in the District Court for the capital city of Warsaw, XIII Wydział Gospodarczy Krajowego Rejestru Sądowego, KRS 0000779253, NIP: 1231431002, REGON: 382960037, address for correspondence ul. ## II. Zasady klasyfikacji

- 2.1.2.1 The classification includes athletes who take part in the Gran Fondo Gdynia race over the Gran Fondo distance, which will take place on 15 May 2022.
- 2.2. The winner of the classification is the rider who finishes the race within the time limit of 7 hours and collects the highest number of points on the mountain.
- 2.3. Mountain are divided into two categories, depending on the category a different number of points is awarded.

For category 1, points are assigned:

- a. 1st place- 10 points
- b. 2nd place-8 points
- c. 3rd place—6 points
- d. 4th place 4 points
- e. 5th place 2 points
- f. 6 th place 1 points

For category 1, points are assigned:

- a. 1st place 5 points
- b. 2nd place 3 points
- c. 3rd place 2 points
- d. 4th place 1 points
- 2.4. 2.4 In the event of a tie in points, the higher place in the Open Classification decides.
